How do I enter?

Can I enter if my project isn't finished yet?

Absolutely! We understand that you may not have fully realized your design at the time of entry—that's ok! Decide on your basic concept and provide as much of the requested information as possible. We'll confirm the details at the time of acceptance into the show.

What sorts of outfits are you looking for?

Just about anything! Stylish, classic, funky, or just plain weird—and everything in between! Any and all materials are encouraged. No matter what you're inspired by—haute couture, steampunk, Anime, trash-to-treasure, Sci-Fi, history, *anything*—it all works! Your outfit must be wearable and suitable for a family-friendly event. Read over the entry form for all the details.

Can we enter as a group?

Absolutely! Entries are open to individuals as well as small groups. Creating a wearable art entry is a fun project for friends and families alike!

Age requirement

We love encouraging young artists! The Primary Contact for the entry must be 18+ but other members of design team may be under 18.

Do I need to buy a ticket to the event?

You do not have to purchase an event ticket to enter the Wearable Runway Art Competition. But if you'd like to join us for dinner, we are offering two reduced-price tickets per accepted entry. You can purchase your 2 tickets in advance (\$20) or at the door (\$25). Additional tickets are \$50 in advance, \$60 at the door.

Who provides the model?

The entrant is responsible for securing a model who will wear their creation. You can model your own entry or enlist help from a friend or family member.

When will I hear if my entry was accepted? What are the details of the event?

We are now accepting entries on a rolling basis. We'll notify you if your entry has been accepted shortly after you apply and will send all contestants detailed information closer to the event.
