Explore the amazing properties of this new substrate created specifically for alcohol inks. This paper can be lifted back to white (no staining) similar to ceramic tile, but without the drawbacks of weight and framing challenges. This makes the paper great for waterscapes and aspen trees!



Ceramic tile paper has a beautiful pearly sheen which simply glows under the vibrant inks. You can work on waterscapes, aspen trees, or a design of your choice. Yupo and ceramic tiles will also be available for comparison.

All supplies included. Experience with alcohol ink or painting is helpful, but not required.
