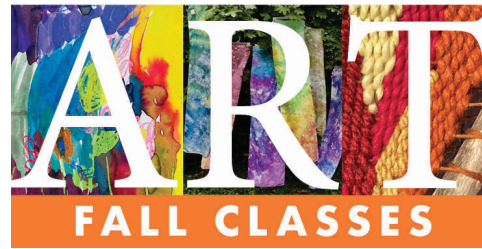

### 501: Movement through Yoga
