Then we delve into guitar techniques used. Students learn rhythm, finger style, bottle neck/slide and alternative tunings. We'll also discuss guitar set up, care and maintenance. This is a group class but students will get individual tips from the instructor. Students need to bring their own guitar and know and be able to play open major chords like G, C, D, A, E, B7.

Fees include instruction, glass, use of all tools, wire/bail hangers and single kiln firing... all you need to do is show up ready to learn, create and have fun!
