- Submission fees are \$5 per entry for members & \$10 for non-members; maximum of three entries submitted per show, except as noted. Works must be labeled with title, artist, and contact information. Forms available at the NAA. Works previously displayed at the NAA are not eligible for entry.
- Hanging work must have picture wire securely fastened with hardware to the back of the frame.
- The NAA reserves the right to decline works that will not hang on our display system or are too fragile, dangerous or inappropriate for public display. The jurors' decisions are final.
- Most receptions are on the second Friday of the month, from 6-8pm with occasional exceptions and are free and open to all.
