4 Mondays, Feb. 19 - March 11, 6:30-8:30 pm 502: Beginner Watercolor

Taught by Karen Berstler, Ages 18+ \$88 Members/\$96 Non-Members Students will be learning a variety of watercolor techniques and how to apply them to a painting. During each class students will practice these techniques first, then have fun putting them into practice. The class is focused on the mechanics of using the paint. Truly a beginner's class, no experience necessary. Experienced watercolor instructor Karen Bertsler will show you how fun and beautiful this medium really is!
